LANOLIN

What is Lanolin?

Lanolin contains Wool Fat and Purified Water which when combined forms an emollient cream that is also protective to the skin. Lanolin penetrates the skin more readily than Wool Fat alone.

What is Lanolin used for?

It can be used for its emollient (softening) and protective properties on dry, cracked or irritated skin, such as cracked nipples.

Does Orion's Lanolin contain pesticide residue?

The materials used by Orion to make Lanolin are of the highest quality and meet current standards of good manufacture. Pesticide residues in Wool Fat are constantly monitored. Wool Fat will only be used to manufacture Orion's Lanolin if it complies with the latest safe standards for pesticide residues. The standard used that is as stated in the British Pharmacopoeia and European Pharmacopoeia is that the sum of all pesticide residues in Wool Fat must not exceed 1 part per million.
