

Composition	Available as Alcohol 95% B.P..
Actions	Alcohol has bactericidal actions against most vegetative organisms. It is not effective against viruses and spores. It acts relatively quickly to denature cellular proteins of microorganisms and lower their surface tension, thus facilitating their removal. It also has useful solvent properties and will dissolve many water-insoluble substances including sebum.
Use	Alcohol 95% B.P. is used in the preparation of pharmaceuticals and alcoholic antiseptics.
Precautions	Not to be swallowed. Keep out of reach of children.
Safety Directions	Avoid contact with the eyes and mouth. Alcoholic solutions are flammable. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoid pooling on surfaces. • Do not use near a naked flame or other ignition source.
First Aid	For advice, contact a Poisons Information Centre or a doctor (at once). If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre, or doctor, or for at least 15 minutes.
Directions For Use	Usage will vary depending on the presentation being used and individual circumstances. Not to be used for disinfection of therapeutic devices.
Storage	Store below 25°C.
